- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 23 (a) There is a Class CT (cinema/theater) (on–sale) beer, wine, and liquor license.

1 (b) The Board may issue the license for use in a cinema or theater that:

2 (1) is in a [stand-alone] building that is designed or used primarily for the 3 exhibition of motion pictures to the public;

- 4 (2) has a capacity to hold at least 100 permanently installed seats; and
- 5 (3) has a minimum of six movie theater rooms.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 7 1, 2022.
