Vehicle Laws – School Bus Safety – Occupant Capacity

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring that a school bus be routed with the intent that the number of pupils on the bus does not exceed the manufacturer's rated seating capacity for 4 $\mathbf{5}$ the bus; requiring that, if an emergency or temporary situation causes the number 6 of pupils to exceed the rated seating capacity, the situation be corrected within a 7 reasonable period of time; and generally relating to school bus safety.
