SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18(A) NEITHER THE STATE NOR ANY UNIT OR INSTRUMENTALITY OF THE19STATE MAY USE ANY APPROPRIATION FOR A MAGNETIC LEVITATION20TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM LOCATED OR TO BE LOCATED IN THE STATE.

(B) SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO EXPENDITURES
