EACH PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL REQUIRE EACH UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT ENROLLED IN THE INSTITUTION TO PASS A UNITED STATES HISTORY COURSE IN ORDER TO EARN AN UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 21 1, 2022.
