15 16	(a) A person may not, by threat, force, or corrupt means, obstruct, impede, or try to obstruct or impede:
17	(1) the administration of justice in a court of the State; OR
18 19	(2) AN OFFICIAL PROCEEDING OF THE EXECUTIVE OR LEGISLATIVE BRANCH.
20 21	(b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 5 years or a fine not exceeding \$10,000 or both.
