- 2 (1) A PUBLIC SCHOOL THAT USES MONTESSORI INSTRUCTION AS ITS
- 3 PRIMARY METHOD OF INSTRUCTION; OR
- 4 (2) A MONTESSORI SCHOOL APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- 5 (B) SUBSECTIONS (C) AND (D) OF THIS SECTION APPLY ONLY TO A 6 CANDIDATE FOR A CERTIFICATE TO TEACH STUDENTS IN A MONTESSORI SCHOOL.
- 7 (C) AN INDIVIDUAL IS ELIGIBLE FOR A CERTIFICATE TO TEACH STUDENTS 8 IN A MONTESSORI SCHOOL IF THE INDIVIDUAL:
- 9 (1) HOLDS A VALID CREDENTIAL FROM:
- 10 (I) THE AMERICAN MONTESSORI SOCIETY;
- 11 (II) THE ASSOCIATION MONTESSORI INTERNATIONALE; OR
- 12 (III) A PROGRAM ACCREDITED BY THE MONTESSORI
- 13 ACCREDITATION COUNCIL FOR TEACHER EDUCATION; AND
- 14 (2) HOLDS A BACHELOR'S DEGREE IN ANY FIELD.
- 15 **(D) (1)** THE STATE BOARD MAY REQUIRE AN INDIVIDUAL TO SUCCESSFULLY PASS AN EXAMINATION TO BE CERTIFIED UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 17 (2) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION,
- 18 AN INDIVIDUAL WHO SATISFIES THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS
- 19 SECTION MAY NOT BE REQUIRED TO MEET ANY ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS TO BE
- 20 CERTIFIED TO TEACH STUDENTS IN A MONTESSORI SCHOOL.
- 21 (E) AN INDIVIDUAL CERTIFIED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT TEACH
- 22 STUDENTS IN A PUBLIC SCHOOL THAT IS NOT A MONTESSORI SCHOOL UNLESS THE
- 23 INDIVIDUAL MEETS ALL OTHER REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO CERTIFICATION OF
- 24 PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS.
- 25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 26 1, 2022.
