1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Montgomery County – Deer Hunting – Sundays**

3 **MC 25–22**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Department of Natural Resources to allow a person to  
5 hunt deer during a certain time period on certain Sundays in Montgomery County;  
6 and generally relating to Sunday deer hunting in Montgomery County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

8 Article – Natural Resources

9 Section 10–410(a)

12 (As enacted by Chapter 95 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2020)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Natural Resources**

16 10–410.

17 (a) (1) The Department may allow a person to hunt on each Sunday of the  
18 game bird and game mammal seasons in:

- 2 (ii) Cecil County;
- 3 (iii) Garrett County;
- 4 (iv) St. Mary's County; and
- 5 (v) Washington County.

6 (2) The Department may allow a person to hunt deer on each Sunday of the  
7 deer hunting seasons from the first Sunday in October through the second Sunday in  
8 January, inclusive, in:

- 9 (i) Carroll County;
- 10 (ii) Dorchester County; and
- 11 (iii) Frederick County.

12 (3) (i) Subject to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, the Department  
13 may allow a person to hunt deer on each Sunday of the deer hunting seasons from 30  
14 minutes before sunrise until 10:30 a.m. in:

15 1. Kent County; AND

16 2. MONTGOMERY COUNTY.

17 (ii) The time restrictions under this paragraph do not apply:

18 1. To a participant in a junior deer hunt authorized under  
19 this subtitle;

20 2. On one Sunday designated by the Department during the  
21 deer firearms season; [and]

22 3. [On] IN KENT COUNTY, ON each Sunday during the deer  
23 bow hunting season and the deer muzzle loader season; AND

24 4. IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ON ONE SUNDAY  
25 DESIGNATED BY THE DEPARTMENT DURING THE DEER BOW HUNTING SEASON.

26 (4) The Department may allow a person to hunt deer during the deer  
27 firearms season:

28 (i) On each Sunday in:

1. Calvert County;
2. Caroline County;
3. Charles County;
4. Harford County;
5. Queen Anne's County;
6. Somerset County; and
7. Worcester County;

(ii) On the first Sunday in:

1. Anne Arundel County; **AND**
2. [Montgomery County; and
- 3.] Talbot County; and

(iii) In Wicomico County, on:

1. The first Sunday; and
2. The second Sunday from 30 minutes before sunrise until

10:30 a.m.

(5) The Department may allow a person to hunt deer during the deer bow hunting season on:

(i) The last three Sundays in October and the first two Sundays in November in:

1. Calvert County;
2. Caroline County;
3. Charles County;
4. Harford County;
5. Queen Anne's County;
6. Somerset County;

- 2                                   8.     Wicomico County; and
- 3                                   9.     Worcester County; and
- 4                                   (ii)   The first Sunday in November in[:
- 5                                   1.]    Anne Arundel County[; and
- 6                                   2.     Montgomery County].

7                   (6)    The Department may allow a person to hunt turkey on each Sunday of  
8 the spring turkey hunting season in:

- 9                                   (i)    Calvert County;
- 10                                  (ii)   Caroline County;
- 11                                  (iii)  Carroll County;
- 12                                  (iv)   Charles County;
- 13                                  (v)    Dorchester County; and
- 14                                  (vi)   Kent County.

15                   (7)    Notwithstanding any other provision of this subtitle, the Department  
16 may allow a person with a deer management permit to shoot deer on any Sunday  
17 throughout the year in accordance with the terms of the permit.

18                   (8)    The Department may allow a person using a State certified raptor to  
19 hunt game birds or mammals on each Sunday during the open season for the game birds  
20 or mammals.

21                   (9)    The Department may allow an unarmed person participating in an  
22 organized fox chase to chase foxes on Sunday.

23                   (10)  The Department may allow a person shooting pen-reared game birds  
24 or tower-released flighted mallard ducks to hunt on Sunday at a regulated shooting ground  
25 in accordance with § 10-906 of this title.

26                   (11)  The Department may allow a person who is 16 years old or younger to  
27 hunt on Sunday if participating in a junior hunt established by the Department in  
28 accordance with this subtitle.

1 (12) Except as provided in paragraphs (8) through (10) of this subsection and  
2 subject to paragraph (7) of this subsection, a person may not hunt on Sunday in:

3 (i) Baltimore City;

4 (ii) Baltimore County;

5 (iii) Howard County; or

6 (iv) Prince George's County.

7 (13) A person may not hunt migratory game birds on Sunday.

8 (14) A person may not hunt on public land within the State park system on  
9 Sunday.

10 (15) The Department may not allow a person to hunt on public land  
11 designated for hunting by the Department on Sunday except in:

12 (i) Allegany County;

13 (ii) Cecil County;

14 (iii) Garrett County;

15 (iv) St. Mary's County;

16 (v) Washington County;

17 (vi) Dorchester County, for turkey during the spring turkey hunting  
18 season; and

19 (vii) Frederick County, for deer from the first Sunday in October  
20 through the second Sunday in January of the following year, inclusive.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
22 1, 2022, the effective date of Section 2 of Chapter 95 of the Acts of the General Assembly of  
23 2020. If the effective date of Section 2 of Chapter 95 is amended, this Act shall take effect  
24 on the taking effect of Section 2 of Chapter 95.
