BY adding to Article – Agriculture Section 2–401 to be under the new subtitle "Subtitle 4. Urban Farmer Assistance" Annotated Code of Maryland (2016 Replacement Volume and 2021 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Agriculture SUBTITLE 4. URBAN FARMER ASSISTANCE.
