BY adding to Article - Transportation Section 21–507(k) Annotated Code of Maryland (2020 Replacement Volume and 2021 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article – Transportation** 21-507.A PEDESTRIAN MAY NOT CATCH OR ATTEMPT TO CATCH FISH BY ANY MEANS ON OR UNDER THE MARYLAND ROUTE 18 KENT ISLAND DRAWBRIDGE OVER THE KENT NARROWS IN QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY.
