## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning 2 School Wellness and Recess Grant Program – Establishment 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the School Wellness and Recess Grant Program; and generally relating to the School Wellness and Recess Grant Program. 4 5 BY adding to 6 Article – Education 7 Section 7–129 8 Annotated Code of Maryland 9 (2018 Replacement Volume and 2021 Supplement) 10 Preamble 11 WHEREAS, Establishing healthy behaviors during childhood is easier and more 12 effective than trying to change unhealthy behaviors during adulthood; and 13 WHEREAS, Schools play a critical role in promoting the health and safety of young 14 people and helping them establish lifelong healthy behaviors; and 15 WHEREAS, A growing body of evidence suggests physical activity benefits students by improving their memory, attention, and concentration, helping them stay 16 17 on-task in the classroom, reducing disruptive behavior in the classroom, and improving 18 their social and emotional development; now, therefore, 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 1 (I) ENSURE THAT PUBLIC SCHOOLS, NONPUBLIC SCHOOLS,
- 2 AND JUDY CENTERS HAVE STRONG, COMPREHENSIVE, AND WRITTEN WELLNESS
- 3 POLICIES THAT ADDRESS THE WHOLE SCHOOL, WHOLE COMMUNITY, WHOLE CHILD
- 4 (WSCC) MODEL; AND
- 5 (II) ENCOURAGE STUDENTS IN PREKINDERGARTEN THROUGH
- 6 GRADE 12 TO PARTICIPATE FULLY IN RECESS BY BEING PHYSICALLY ACTIVE AND
- 7 ENGAGED WITH THEIR PEERS IN ACTIVITIES OF THEIR CHOICE.
- 8 (C) (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL IMPLEMENT AND ADMINISTER THE
- 9 Program in accordance with this section.
- 10 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL AWARD GRANTS FROM THE PROGRAM
- 11 TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS, NONPUBLIC SCHOOLS, AND JUDY CENTERS TO SUPPORT
- 12 EXISTING SCHOOL WELLNESS AND RECESS PROGRAMS.
- 13 (3) TO THE EXTENT PRACTICABLE, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
- 14 PRIORITIZE GRANT AWARDS TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS, NONPUBLIC SCHOOLS, AND
- 15 JUDY CENTERS BASED ON:
- 16 (I) THE QUANTIFIABLE MEASURE OF NEED OF THE SCHOOL
- 17 OR CENTER;
- 18 (II) THE INCLUSION OF ALL STUDENTS IN THE SCHOOL OR
- 19 CENTER, INCLUDING STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES AS DEFINED IN 45 C.F.R. §
- 20 **84.3(J)**;
- 21 (III) WHETHER THE SCHOOL OR CENTER HAS A WRITTEN
- 22 WELLNESS POLICY THAT ADDRESSES THE WHOLE SCHOOL, WHOLE COMMUNITY,
- 23 WHOLE CHILD (WSCC) MODEL; AND
- 24 (IV) WHETHER THE SCHOOL OR CENTER WOULD PROVIDE
- 25 GEOGRAPHIC DIVERSITY AMONG THE GRANTEES.
- 26 (D) THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN
- 27 APPROPRIATION OF \$500,000 TO THE PROGRAM.
- 28 (E) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE
- 29 REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
- 30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 31 July 1, 2022.
