 individual to fill fany A vacancy of fan THE appointed member of the county board for the
 remainder of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (II) AN APPOINTMENT MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS
 PARAGRAPH IS SUBJECT TO THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL
 BY A VOTE OF AT LEAST FIVE MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL.
- 31 <u>SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED</u>, That, of the three appointed 32 members of the Harford County Board of Education who are serving on the effective date 33 of this Act:

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1	(1) the terms of the two members whose terms are scheduled to expire on
2	June 30, 2023, shall terminate on June 30, 2023; and
3	(2) the term of the one member whose term is scheduled to expire on June
4	30, 2023, shall expire on June 30, 2023, and the member appointed by the Harford County
5	Executive, subject to the advice and consent of the Harford County Council, shall succeed
6	the appointed member and serve for a term of 4 years beginning July 1, 2023, until a
7	successor is appointed and qualifies.

8 SECTION = <u>2.</u> AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 9 July 1, 2022.
