- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
   That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19 Article Tax General
- 20 10–208.

(a) In addition to the modification under § 10–207 of this subtitle, the amounts
 under this section are subtracted from the federal adjusted gross income of a resident to
 determine Maryland adjusted gross income.

1 (BB) (1) (I) IN THIS SUBSECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE 2 MEANINGS INDICATED.

3 (II) "EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PROVIDER" HAS THE 4 MEANING STATED IN § 13–516 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE.

5 (III) "ESSENTIAL HEALTH CARE WORKER" MEANS A LICENSED 6 PHYSICIAN, A LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE, A REGISTERED NURSE, OR AN 7 EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PROVIDER WHO PERFORMED A DUTY OR WORK 8 RESPONSIBILITY:

9 1. DURING A STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARED BY THE 10 GOVERNOR UNDER TITLE 14 OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY ARTICLE DUE TO THE 11 COVID-19 PANDEMIC; AND

122.THAT COULD NOT BE PERFORMED REMOTELY OR WAS13REQUIRED TO BE COMPLETED AT THE WORK SITE.

14(IV) "LICENSED PHYSICIAN" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN §1514–101 OF THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE.

16(V)"LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE" AND "REGISTERED NURSE"17HAVE THE MEANINGS STATED IN § 8–101 OF THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE.

18 (2) FOR A TAXABLE YEAR BEGINNING AFTER DECEMBER 31, 2020, 19 BUT BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2023, THE SUBTRACTION ALLOWED UNDER SUBSECTION 20 (A) OF THIS SECTION INCLUDES AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO \$2,000 IF AN INDIVIDUAL IS 21 AN ESSENTIAL HEALTH CARE WORKER.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three—fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted. It shall remain effective through June 30, 2023, and, at the end of June 30, 2023, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
