1 (B) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1 EACH YEAR, BALTIMORE CITY SHALL MAIL 2 A NOTICE OF THE TAX CREDIT UNDER § 9–105 OF THIS SUBTITLE TO EACH 3 HOMEOWNER IN BALTIMORE CITY:

4 (1) WHO HAS NOT APPLIED FOR THE TAX CREDIT UNDER § 9–105 OF 5 THIS SUBTITLE; AND

6 (2) WHOSE DWELLING HAS AN ASSESSED VALUE, WHEN FULLY 7 PHASED IN, IN THE CURRENT 3-YEAR ASSESSMENT CYCLE THAT IS MORE THAN 10% 8 GREATER THAN THE DWELLING'S ASSESSED VALUE, WHEN FULLY PHASED IN, IN THE 9 IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING 3-YEAR ASSESSMENT CYCLE.

10 (C) THE NOTICE SHALL INCLUDE:

11 (1) A COPY OF THE APPLICATION FOR THE TAX CREDIT UNDER § 12 9–105 OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND

A SEPARATE INSERT THAT INCLUDES:

14 (I) THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT IN CONSPICUOUS TYPE: 15 "BECAUSE THE VALUE OF YOUR HOME HAS INCREASED, THE AMOUNT OF PROPERTY 16 TAXES YOU OWE WILL ALSO INCREASE. BUT THE AMOUNT OF YOUR TAX INCREASE 17 WILL BE SIGNIFICANTLY LESS IF YOU QUALIFY FOR THE HOMESTEAD PROPERTY 18 TAX CREDIT. YOU ARE STRONGLY ENCOURAGED TO APPLY FOR THE HOMESTEAD 19 PROPERTY TAX CREDIT."; AND

20(II)ANY OTHER RELEVANT INFORMATION, AS DETERMINED BY21BALTIMORE CITY.

22 (D) BALTIMORE CITY SHALL PAY ALL COSTS TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION.

(E) ON OR BEFORE NOVEMBER 1 EACH YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
PROVIDE BALTIMORE CITY WITH A LIST OF THE HOMEOWNERS TO WHOM THE
NOTICE MUST BE MAILED ON OR BEFORE THE FOLLOWING JANUARY 1.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 27 1, 2022.
