11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Criminal Procedure**

14 15–407.

15 (a) This section applies only in Carroll County.

16 (b) (1) (i) The State’s Attorney’s salary is the following percentages of the
17 salary of a judge of the District Court of Maryland:

18 1. 80%, ending on December 3, 2018;
