## A BILL ENTITLED

2 Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System - Benefits

- FOR the purpose of altering the method for calculating the retirement allowance for certain retirees of the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System for service earned on or after a certain date; altering the maximum benefit that certain retirees of the Law
- 6 Enforcement Officers' Pension System may receive; and generally relating to the

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article State Personnel and Pensions
- 16 26–401.

- 17 (b) (1) Except as provided in paragraphs (2), (3), and (4) of this subsection, on
- 18 retirement under this section, a member is entitled to receive a normal service retirement
- 19 allowance that equals:
- 20 (I) the number of years of the member's creditable service ON OR
- 21 BEFORE JUNE 30, 2022, multiplied by 2% of the member's average final compensation;
- 22 AND

1	(II) THE NUMBER OF YEARS OF THE MEMBER'S CREDITABLE
2	SERVICE ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2022, MULTIPLIED BY 2.5% OF THE MEMBER'S
3	AVERAGE FINAL COMPENSATION.

- 4 (2) A member's normal service retirement allowance under paragraph (1) of this subsection may not exceed [65%] **70%** of the member's average final compensation.
- 6 (3) (i) This paragraph applies only to a member who is not subject to 7 the Law Enforcement Officers' Modified Pension Benefit under Subtitle 2, Part II of this 8 title.
- 9 (ii) Except as provided in paragraph (4) of this subsection, on 10 retirement under this paragraph, the member is entitled to receive a normal service 11 retirement allowance that equals:
- 12 1. 2.3% of the member's average final compensation multiplied by each year of the member's first 30 years of creditable service; and
- 14 2. 1% of the member's average final compensation multiplied by each year of creditable service in excess of 30 years.
- 16 (4) Subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, on retirement under this section, if a member's annuity is greater than the member's normal service retirement allowance calculated under paragraph (1) or (3) of this subsection, the member's normal service retirement allowance shall equal the member's annuity.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2022.
