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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Real Estate Brokers, Salespersons, and Associate Brokers – Continuing**  
3 **Education Courses – Verification of Identity**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring an instructor of a continuing education course for real estate  
5 brokers, salespersons, and associate brokers to require an individual enrolled in a  
6 certain course to provide certain documentation to verify the identity of the  
7 individual; and generally relating to continuing education courses for real estate  
8 brokers, salespersons, and associate brokers.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – Business Occupations and Professions**

22 17–315.

23 (a) (1) To qualify for renewal of a license under this subtitle, a licensee shall  
24 complete at least 15 clock hours of continuing education instruction, as provided in  
25 subsection (b) of this section, during the preceding 2–year term.

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EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

1 (c) (1) Continuing education courses may be conducted by:

2 (i) the Maryland Association of Realtors or its member boards;

3 (ii) the Real Estate Brokers of Baltimore, Inc.;

4 (iii) any similar professional association; or

5 (iv) an educational institution approved by the Commission.

6 (2) Continuing education courses shall be taught by a qualified instructor  
7 who is experienced in the real estate industry.

8 (3) On or before January 1, 2003, the Commission shall adopt regulations  
9 that provide for the conduct of continuing education instruction courses by:

10 (i) remote access satellite;

11 (ii) closed-circuit video;

12 (iii) computer, including transmission over the Internet and the  
13 World Wide Web;

14 (iv) home study; and

15 (v) any other delivery system approved by the Commission.

16 (4) **TO VERIFY THE IDENTITY OF AN INDIVIDUAL ENROLLED IN A**  
17 **CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSE, THE INSTRUCTOR SHALL REQUIRE, AS A**  
18 **CONDITION OF PARTICIPATING IN THE COURSE, THAT THE INDIVIDUAL PROVIDE:**

19 (I) **FOR AN IN-PERSON COURSE, A PHOTO IDENTIFICATION;**  
20 **AND**

21 (II) **FOR A VIRTUAL OR OTHER REMOTE COURSE, A SIGNED**  
22 **AFFIDAVIT ATTESTING TO THE IDENTITY OF THE INDIVIDUAL.**

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
24 October 1, 2022.
