# Marine Contractor License – Performance of Services – Licensing Requirements and Fees

- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing an individual who is employed by a county or municipality 5 in the State to perform marine contractor services while in the performance of the
- 6 duties of their employment without having to obtain a marine contractor license
- 7 under certain circumstances; exempting the individual from paying certain licensing
- 8 and testing fees; and generally relating to marine contractor licenses and fees.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
  That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article Environment
- 17 17-301.

18 (a) Except as otherwise provided in this title, a person shall be licensed by the 19 Board as a marine contractor or be employed by an individual or entity that is licensed as 20 a marine contractor before the person may:

- 21 (1) Perform marine contractor services in the State; or
- 22 (2) Solicit to perform marine contractor services in the State.
- 23 (b) An individual or an entity may qualify for a license.

1 (c) An individual who is employed by an agency of the federal government or the 2 State may perform marine contractor services while in the performance of the duties of 3 their employment without having to obtain a license from the Board under this title.

4 (d) A residential or commercial property owner may perform marine contractor 5 services on the property owner's own property without having to obtain a license from the 6 Board under this title.

7 (E) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS EMPLOYED 8 BY A COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY IN THE STATE.

9 (2) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO PERFORMS MARINE CONTRACTOR SERVICES 10 WHILE IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THE DUTIES OF THEIR EMPLOYMENT IS NOT 11 REQUIRED TO PAY A FEE FOR:

(I) THE ISSUANCE OR RENEWAL OF A LICENSE; OR

(II) A TEST ADMINISTERED BY THE BOARD.

14 (3) (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS 15 PARAGRAPH, AN INDIVIDUAL MAY PERFORM MARINE CONTRACTOR SERVICES 16 WHILE IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THE DUTIES OF THEIR EMPLOYMENT WITHOUT 17 HAVING TO OBTAIN A LICENSE FROM THE BOARD UNDER THIS TITLE IF THE 18 INDIVIDUAL IS PERFORMING MARINE CONTRACTOR SERVICES FOR:

THE ROUTINE MAINTENANCE OR REPAIR OF A TIDAL
 IMPOUNDMENT DIKE, AN AGRICULTURAL DRAINAGE DITCH, A HIGHWAY DRAINAGE
 DITCH, A ROADSIDE DRAINAGE DITCH, OR AN OUTLET FOR A ROADSIDE DRAINAGE
 DITCH; OR

23 2. ANY OTHER MARINE CONTRACTOR SERVICE THAT 24 THE BOARD DETERMINES WOULD PRESENT A DE MINIMIS RISK TO HUMAN HEALTH 25 OR THE ENVIRONMENT.

(II) IF AN INDIVIDUAL IS PERFORMING MARINE CONTRACTOR
 SERVICES FOR THE ROUTINE MAINTENANCE OR REPAIR OF AN EXISTING SHORE
 EROSION CONTROL STRUCTURE, THE INDIVIDUAL SHALL OBTAIN A LICENSE FROM
 THE BOARD UNDER THIS TITLE.

30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 31 October 1, 2022.
