BY adding to Article - Education Section <del>12-124</del> 15-134 Annotated Code of Maryland (2018 Replacement Volume and 2021 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Education <del>12-124.</del> 15-134.

14 15 16 17 18	(2) THE POLICY UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL INCLUDE A PROVISION TO REIMBURSE TUITION AND FEES FOR THE SEMESTER IN WHICH A STUDENT WITHDRAWS IF THE EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES INHIBIT THE STUDENT'S ABILITY TO ACQUIRE AN EDUCATION AT THE PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION, AS DEFINED IN THE POLICY.
