2 **Calvert County – Board of License Commissioners – Compensation**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the annual compensation of the chair and members of the
4 Board of License Commissioners for Calvert County; and generally relating to the
5 Board of License Commissioners for Calvert County.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

3 (a) (1) The chair of the Board shall receive [~~\$4,200~~] **\$5,000** annually for
4 expenses incurred while performing the duties of the office.

5 (2) Each regular member of the Board shall receive [~~\$3,600~~] **\$4,350**
6 annually for expenses incurred while performing the duties of the office.

7 (3) The substitute member of the Board shall receive \$200 for each meeting
8 of the Board attended as an acting regular member for expenses incurred while performing
9 the duties of the office.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35
11 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary
12 or compensation of the chair and other members of the Board of License Commissioners for
13 Calvert County while serving in a term of office beginning before the effective date of this
14 Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the chair and
15 other members of the Board of License Commissioners for Calvert County shall take effect
16 at the beginning of the next following term of office. This limitation does not apply to an
17 individual appointed or elected after the effective date of this Act to fill out an unexpired
18 term.

19 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
20 1, 2022.
