### Article – Education

18 **13–105.** 

(A) IN FISCAL YEAR 2023, THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND, COLLEGE PARK
 CAMPUS MAY NOT USE MORE THAN 12% OF REVENUES DERIVED FROM STUDENT
 FEES FOR THE ATHLETIC DEPARTMENT.

22 (B) (1) BEGINNING IN FISCAL YEAR 2024, THE UNIVERSITY OF 23 MARYLAND, COLLEGE PARK CAMPUS SHALL REDUCE THE PERCENTAGE OF

#### HOUSE BILL 895

1 REVENUES DERIVED FROM STUDENT FEES USED FOR THE ATHLETIC DEPARTMENT 2 BY 0.5% EACH YEAR.

3 (2) BEGINNING IN FISCAL YEAR 2047, THE UNIVERSITY OF 4 MARYLAND, COLLEGE PARK CAMPUS MAY NOT USE ANY OF THE REVENUES 5 DERIVED FROM STUDENT FEES FOR THE ALETHIC DEPARTMENT.

6 (C) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2023, AND EACH DECEMBER 1 7 THEREAFTER, THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND, COLLEGE PARK CAMPUS SHALL 8 SUBMIT A REPORT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT 9 ARTICLE, TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON THE PROGRESS OF MEETING THE 10 REQUIREMENTS UNDER THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July1, 2022.
