- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

16 (A) IF THE GOVERNOR DOES NOT INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL 17 AN APPROPRIATION SUFFICIENT TO PROVIDE STEP INCREASES FOR STATE 18 EMPLOYEES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE APPLICABLE PAY PLAN, THE GOVERNOR 19 SHALL REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1257 OF 20 THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE REASONS WHY AN APPROPRIATION FOR 21 THE STEP INCREASES WAS NOT INCLUDED IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL.

(B) THE GOVERNOR SHALL SUBMIT THE REPORT REQUIRED UNDER
SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION ON THE DATE ON WHICH THE ANNUAL BUDGET
BILL IS SUBMITTED TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.
