6 (5) "YOUTH SPORTS PROGRAM" MEANS A PROGRAM ORGANIZED FOR 7 TACKLE FOOTBALL-RELATED RECREATIONAL ATHLETIC COMPETITION OR 8 INSTRUCTION FOR PARTICIPANTS WHO ARE UNDER THE AGE OF 14 YEARS.

9 (B) EACH ANNUAL TACKLE FOOTBALL SEASON SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE 10 MONTHS OF AUGUST THROUGH DECEMBER.

11 (C) A YOUTH SPORTS PROGRAM MAY NOT PROVIDE TACKLE FOOTBALL 12 GAMES FOR YOUTH ATHLETES DURING THE MONTHS OF JANUARY THROUGH JULY.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July14 1, 2022.
