- FOR the purpose of requiring the Office of the Attorney General to submit an advice of counsel letter on the impact of a certain Supreme Court case; and generally relating to the regulation of firearms.
- 6 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 7 That the Office of the Attorney General shall:
- 8 (1) monitor the case of New York State Rifle & Pistol Association Inc. v. 9 Bruen argued before the United States Supreme Court on November 3, 2021; and
- 10 (2) on or before September 1, 2022, submit an advice of counsel letter to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, to the
- 12 Senate Judicial Proceedings Committee, the House Judiciary Committee, the President of
- the Senate, and the Speaker of the House on the effect of the New York State Rifle & Pistol
- 14 Association Inc. v. Bruen case on State firearm laws.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2022.
