- 1 AN ACT concerning
- 2 Anne Arundel County Public Schools Preventive Measure Unit Pilot Program
- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Preventive Measure Unit Pilot Program in Anne
- 4 Arundel County to establish preventive measure units in elementary and middle
- 5 schools to monitor in a certain manner students who have behavioral, social, or legal
- 6 difficulties; and generally relating to the Preventive Measure Unit Pilot Program in

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article Education
- 16 **7–450.**
- 17 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "PROGRAM" MEANS THE PREVENTIVE MEASURE
- 18 UNIT PILOT PROGRAM.
- 19 (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY.
- 20 (C) THERE IS A PREVENTIVE MEASURE UNIT PILOT PROGRAM.
- 21 (D) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO ESTABLISH PREVENTIVE
- 22 MEASURE UNITS IN ELEMENTARY AND MIDDLE SCHOOLS TO MONITOR STUDENTS

- 1 WHO HAVE BEHAVIORAL, SOCIAL, OR LEGAL DIFFICULTIES IN OR OUT OF SCHOOL
- 2 THROUGH:
- 3 (1) INCREASED MONITORING AND ATTENTION; AND
- 4 (2) INDIVIDUALIZED NETWORKING WITH COMMUNITY PROGRAMS, 5 SCHOOLS, STUDENTS, AND PARENTS.
- 6 (E) THE PROGRAM SHALL BE CONDUCTED DURING THE 2023–2024 AND 7 2024–2025 SCHOOL YEARS.
- 8 (F) (1) THE COUNTY BOARD, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE ANNE 9 ARUNDEL COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY 10 MENTAL HEALTH AGENCY, SHALL SELECT THREE OR FOUR ELEMENTARY OR 11 MIDDLE SCHOOLS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM.
- 12 **(2)** The administration, teachers, and staff of each 13 selected school shall cooperate with the preventive measure unit in
- 14 THE PERFORMANCE OF ITS DUTIES.
- 15 (G) ON OR BEFORE FEBRUARY 1, 2024, AND EACH FEBRUARY 1
 16 THEREAFTER, THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN
 17 ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, ON THE
 18 EFFECTIVENESS OF THE PROGRAM.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2022. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of June 30, 2025, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
