A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Safety – Body–Worn Cameras – Costs and Expenses**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State to be responsible for certain costs and expenses
4 related to the procurement and use of certain body–worn cameras by certain law
5 enforcement agencies; and generally relating to law enforcement and body–worn
6 cameras.

- 18 1. the Department of State Police;
- 19 2. the Anne Arundel County Police Department;
- 20 3. the Howard County Police Department; and
