(iv) 7 [(13)] **(7)** A person may not hunt migratory game birds on Sunday. 8 [(14)] (8) A person may not hunt on public land within the State park system on Sunday. 9 10 [(15)] (9) The Department may [not] allow a person to hunt on public land 11 designated for hunting by the Department on Sunday [except in: 12 (i) Allegany County; 13 Cecil County; (ii) 14 (iii) Garrett County; St. Mary's County; 15 (iv) 16 Washington County; (v) 17 (vi) Dorchester County, for turkey during the spring turkey hunting 18 season; and 19 Frederick County, for deer from the first Sunday in October 20 through the second Sunday in January of the following year, inclusive]. 21Except as provided in paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection, a 22person, other than the owner or occupant, while hunting for any wild bird or mammal may 23not shoot or discharge any firearm or other deadly weapon within 150 yards, known as the 24"safety zone", of a dwelling house, residence, church, or other building or camp occupied by 25human beings, or shoot at any wild bird or mammal while it is within this area, without 26 the specific advance permission of the owner or occupant. 27 A person, while hunting for any wild bird or mammal, may not shoot or 28 discharge any firearm within 300 yards of a public or nonpublic school during school hours 29 or at a time when a school-approved activity is taking place.

- 1 (3) [(i)] For archery hunters [in Allegany County, Calvert County, 2 Carroll County, Cecil County, Frederick County, Garrett County, Harford County, 3 Montgomery County, St. Mary's County, or Washington County], the safety zone described in paragraph (1) of this subsection extends for 50 yards from a dwelling house, residence, church, or any other building or camp occupied by human beings.
- [(ii) For archery hunters in Anne Arundel County, the safety zone described in paragraph (1) of this subsection extends for 100 yards from a dwelling house, residence, church, or any other building or camp occupied by human beings.]
- 9 (4) During any open hunting season, a person, other than the owner or occupant, may not hunt or chase willfully any wild bird or mammal within the safety zone without the specific advance permission of the owner or occupant.
- 12 (5) In Harford County, an archery hunter shall use a tree stand when 13 hunting any wild bird or mammal within 50 to 100 yards of a dwelling house, residence, 14 church, public or nonpublic school, or other building or camp occupied by human beings.
- 15 (6) In Montgomery County or Washington County, an archery hunter shall 16 be in an elevated position that allows the hunter to shoot in a downward trajectory when 17 hunting any wild bird or mammal within 50 to 100 yards of a dwelling house, residence, 18 church, public or nonpublic school, or other building or camp occupied by human beings.

- 20 (b) (3) (i) As part of the application for a regulated shooting ground permit, 21 a person may apply to the Department for authorization to allow hunting on Sunday as 22 provided under [§ 10–410(a)(2)(iii)] § 10–410(A)(5) of this title.
