- 1 (I) THE CRIME OR CRIMES WERE REPORTED TO LAW 2 ENFORCEMENT; OR
- 3 (II) THE PREVIOUS OFFENDER WAS CHARGED WITH, CONVICTED 4 OF, OR FOUND RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CRIME OR CRIMES.
- 5 (B) A KNOWING PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN OF A PREVIOUS OFFENDER
 6 MAY NOT ALLOW THE PREVIOUS OFFENDER TO BE IN THE PRESENCE OF ANOTHER
 7 MINOR WITHOUT ADULT SUPERVISION ADEQUATE TO PREVENT THE PREVIOUS

- 9 (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY 10 OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT 11 EXCEEDING 2 YEARS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$10,000 OR BOTH.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 2022.
