 - MEDICAL CARE PROGRAMS ADMINISTRATION IN PARAGRAPHS (3) THROUGH (6)
 OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE USED TO FUND WAGE INCREASES FOR:

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(I) HEALTH CARE WORKERS; AND

(II) STAFF IN NURSING HOMES WHO PROVIDE DIRECT CARE TO RESIDENTS, INCLUDING HOUSEKEEPING, LAUNDRY, NUTRITIONAL, AND ACTIVITIES SERVICES.

30 (8) The Governor's proposed budget for fiscal year [2021] **2024** and each 31 fiscal year thereafter shall be presented in the same manner, including object and program 32 information, as in the fiscal year [2020] **2023** budget.

33 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 34 October 1, 2022.
