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# Health Occupations Boards - Authority Over Infrastructure - Staffing and **Operations**

4 FOR the purpose of establishing that the Secretary of Health has authority over the 5 infrastructure operations of health occupations boards and commissions; altering the 6 method of selecting officers of certain health occupations boards; establishing 7 procedures for the filling of certain vacancies on a certain health occupations board; 8 requiring the Secretary of Budget and Management, in consultation with the 9 Secretary of Health, to determine the positions for which the Secretary of Health 10 may set compensation; prohibiting certain special funds from being used to pay for 11 infrastructure operations; and generally relating to the organization and operation 12 of health occupations boards.
