CHAPTER

AN ACT concerning 1

2 Higher Education - Returned Peace Corps Volunteers - In-State Tuition

- FOR the purpose of exempting returned Peace Corps volunteers who are domiciled in the 4 State from paying nonresident tuition at a public institution of higher education in the State; establishing that returned Peace Corps volunteer students shall be included as in-State residents for the computation of State aid to community colleges; requiring the Maryland Higher Education Commission to adopt regulations; and generally relating to the residency requirement for in-State tuition purposes.

- 10 COMMUNITY COLLEGES IN ACCORDANCE WITH §§ 16–305 AND 16–512 OF THIS
- 11 ARTICLE.
- 12 **(D)** THE COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE 13 PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 15 1, 2022.
