An owner of residential real property in the State that is not SUBJECT TO A MORTGAGE SHALL MAINTAIN HOMEOWNER'S INSURANCE WITH LIABILITY COVERAGE OF AT LEAST \$100,000 FOR BODILY OR PERSONAL INJURY OCCURRING ON THE PROPERTY. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
