BY adding to Article – Health Occupations Section 1-610 Annotated Code of Maryland (2021 Replacement Volume) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Health Occupations 1-610.(A) **EXECUTE** AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, IF A HEALTH OCCUPATIONS BOARD INVESTIGATES A LICENSEE OR, CERTIFICATE HOLDER, OR REGISTRATION HOLDER AND THE INVESTIGATION MAY RESULT IN CHARGES OR SANCTIONS AGAINST THE LICENSEE OR, CERTIFICATE HOLDER, OR

- 27 (2) (I) VIOLATING THE RULES OF PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT; OR
- 28 (II) ACTING IN A MANNER THAT IS PREJUDICIAL TO THE
- 29 ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE.
- 30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 31 October 1, 2022.
