- FOR the purpose of establishing a pollution fee to be charged by the Department of the Environment and collected by the Comptroller on certain new motor vehicles sold or registered in the State based on certain pollution ratings; exempting certain motor vehicles from the fee and requiring the Department of Transportation to review the exemptions; requiring the fee to be deposited in the Maryland Strategic Energy Investment Fund; and generally relating to a pollution fee on new motor vehicles.

- 3 (A) A FEE SHALL BE CHARGED BY THE DEPARTMENT AND COLLECTED BY
- 4 THE COMPTROLLER ON EACH NEW MOTOR VEHICLE SOLD OR REGISTERED IN THE
- 5 STATE WITH A U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY CARBON DIOXIDE
- 6 POLLUTION RATING EQUAL TO OR HIGHER THAN THE MINIMUM POLLUTION LEVEL.
- 7 (B) THE FEE SHALL BE BASED ON THE RATING BY THE U.S.
- 8 ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY OF THE CARBON DIOXIDE TAILPIPE
- 9 EXHAUST OF PASSENGER VEHICLES AND LIGHT TRUCKS.
- 10 (C) THE MINIMUM POLLUTION LEVEL SHALL:
- 11 (1) BE 400 GRAMS PER MILE IN THE 2023 MODEL YEAR; AND
- 12 (2) DECREASE EACH MODEL YEAR BY 10 GRAMS PER MILE.
- 13 (D) THE FEE SHALL BE \$1.25 TIMES THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL
