- FOR the purpose of repealing certain provisions of law relating to the prescription, administration, and regulation of amygdalin; and generally relating to amygdalin.

- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 11 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 12 Article Health General
- 13 [18–302.
- 14 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a physician may prescribe 15 or administer amygdalin to treat cancer.
- 16 (b) (1) A hospital or health facility may not restrict or prohibit the use of amygdalin that a physician, with the consent of a patient, prescribes for or administers to
- 18 the patient.
- 19 (2) (i) The Department may restrict or prohibit the use of amygdalin in
- 20 the treatment of a patient if, after a hearing, the Department finds that the manner in
- 21 which the amygdalin is prescribed or administered is harmful to the patient.

- 3 (c) The Department and the State Board of Pharmacy shall regulate the 4 manufacture, distribution, and sale of amygdalin for use in this State, but only to ensure 5 that the amygdalin is not adulterated, contaminated by microorganisms, or misbranded.]
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2022.
