A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Courts – Prohibited Indemnity and Defense Liability Agreements

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a provision in a contract with a design professional for professional services that requires the design professional to indemnify or hold harmless certain parties unless the design professional is at fault for causing the loss, damage, or expense indemnified; prohibiting a provision in a contract with a design professional for professional services that requires the design professional to defend certain parties against liability or certain claims; and generally relating to indemnity and defense liability agreements.

(VII) "PROFESSIONAL SERVICES" MEANS SERVICES OR WORK THAT CONSTITUTES THE PRACTICE OF A PROFESSION REGULATED BY, OR FOR WHICH LICENSURE IS REQUIRED UNDER, TITLE 3, TITLE 8, TITLE 9, TITLE 14, OR TITLE 15 OF THE BUSINESS OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS ARTICLE.

6 (2) A **PROVISION**, covenant, promise, agreement, or understanding in, or in connection with or collateral to, a contract or agreement relating to architectural, 7 engineering, inspecting, or surveying services, or the construction, alteration, repair, or 8 maintenance of a building, structure, HIGHWAY, ROAD, appurtenance or appliance, 9 10 including moving, demolition, and excavating connected with those services or that work, purporting to indemnify the promisee against liability for damages arising out of bodily 11 injury to any person or damage to property caused by or resulting from the sole negligence 12of the promisee or indemnitee, or the agents or employees of the promisee or indemnitee, is 1314against public policy and is void and unenforceable.

3 (6) THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT BE INTERPRETED TO PROHIBIT AN 4 OTHERWISE ENFORCEABLE INDEMNITY OR HOLD HARMLESS PROVISION IN ANY $\mathbf{5}$ CONTRACT OR AGREEMENT FROM INCLUDING RECOVERY OF REASONABLE 6 ATTORNEY'S FEES AND DEFENSE COSTS ACTUALLY INCURRED BY THE PROMISEE TO 7 DEFEND AGAINST THIRD-PARTY CLAIMS FOR DAMAGES, LOSSES, OR EXPENSES, 8 ALLEGED IN ANY COURT, TRIBUNAL, OR ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION 9 PROCEDURE REQUIRED OF THE PROMISEE BY LAW OR BY CONTRACT, IN CASES WHERE THE FAULT OF THE PROMISOR OR ITS DERIVATIVE PARTIES IS DETERMINED 10 TO BE THE PROXIMATE CAUSE OF THE DEFENSE COSTS TO BE INDEMNIFIED. 11

[(3)] (7) This subsection does not affect the validity of any insurance contract, workers' compensation, any general indemnity agreement required by a surety as a condition of execution of a bond for a construction or other contract, or any other agreement issued by an insurer.
