1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Board of Heating, Ventilation, Air-Conditioning, and Refrigeration**
3 **Contractors – Sunset Extension**

4 FOR the purpose of continuing the State Board of Heating, Ventilation, Air-Conditioning,
5 and Refrigeration Contractors in accordance with the provisions of the Maryland
6 Program Evaluation Act (sunset law) by extending to a certain date the termination
7 provisions relating to the statutory and regulatory authority of the Board; and
8 generally relating to the State Board of Heating, Ventilation, Air-Conditioning, and
9 Refrigeration Contractors.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Business Regulation**

1 Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Maryland Program
2 Evaluation Act, this title and all regulations adopted under this title shall terminate and
3 be of no effect after July 1, [2023] **2033**.

5 October 1, 2022.
