3 FOR the purpose of continuing the State Board of Architects in accordance with the
4 provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act (sunset law) by extending to a
5 certain date the termination provisions relating to certain statutory and regulatory
6 authority of the Board; and generally relating to the State Board of Architects.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
