- 2 (B) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2023, THE STATE BOARD SHALL DEVELOP 3 GUIDELINES FOR INSTRUCTIONAL CONTENT ON THE SEPTEMBER 11, 2001, 4 TERRORIST ATTACKS THAT IS AGE-APPROPRIATE, INTERDISCIPLINARY, AND 5 CONSISTENT WITH OTHER REQUIRED GRADE-LEVEL INSTRUCTION.
- 6 (C) A NONPUBLIC SCHOOL THAT DOES NOT PARTICIPATE IN STATE-FUNDED EDUCATION PROGRAMS IS ENCOURAGED TO INCLUDE IN THE CURRICULUM A UNIT OF INSTRUCTION ON THE SEPTEMBER 11, 2001, TERRORIST ATTACKS CONSISTENT WITH GUIDELINES DEVELOPED BY THE STATE BOARD UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.
