- 10 (2) PROVIDE IN THE COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT BUDGET SUFFICIENT FUNDING TO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS UNDER ITEM (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2022.
