# Health - Automated External Defibrillator, First Aid, and CPR - Requirements for Health Clubs

FOR the purpose of establishing requirements regarding the availability of automated
external defibrillators and the presence of employees who are certified in first aid
and cardiopulmonary resuscitation at health clubs; providing immunity from civil
liability for employees of health clubs regarding the presence or use of or failure to
use an automated external defibrillator; and generally relating to health clubs and
emergency services.
