A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City – Alcoholic Beverages Licenses – Transfer**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the transfer of a certain Class A alcoholic beverages license
4 from a certain area in Baltimore City to another area in Baltimore City; and
5 generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Baltimore City.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

19 12–102.

20 This title applies only in Baltimore City.

21 12–1707.

22 (a) The alcoholic beverages districts described in this section at all times are
23 coterminous with the legislative districts in the Legislative Districting Plan of 2012.
