2 **Young Readers Programs – Establishment**
3 **(Young Readers Program Expansion Act)**

4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Baltimore City Young Readers Program within the
5 Division of Children and Youth of the Governor’s Office of Crime Prevention, Youth,
6 and Victim Services to mail free, high–quality books to certain children; establishing
7 the Young Readers Matching Grant Program within the Division to provide
8 matching grants to ~~counties~~ affiliated services to support the establishment and
9 operation of book gifting services; requiring the Deputy Director of the Division to
10 administer the programs; authorizing an affiliated service to apply for a program
11 grant; requiring a program grant to be disbursed to a qualifying affiliated service;
12 and generally relating to Young Readers Programs.

7 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
8 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

10 **SUBTITLE 14. YOUNG READERS PROGRAMS.**

11 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS

13 (2) "AFFILIATED SERVICE" MEANS A BOOK-GIFTING SERVICE
14 ~~AFFILIATED WITH DOLLY PARTON'S IMAGINATION LIBRARY~~ PERFORMED BY A
15 NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION THAT IS TAX EXEMPT UNDER § 501(C)(3) OF THE
16 INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OR A UNIT OF STATE, COUNTY, OR MUNICIPAL
17 GOVERNMENT THAT FORMS AN AFFILIATED PARTNERSHIP WITH AN EARLY READER
18 ORGANIZATION.

19 (3) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE YOUNG READERS MATCHING GRANT
20 PROGRAM.

21 (B) THERE IS A YOUNG READERS MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM IN THE
22 DIVISION.

23 (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO ~~COUNTIES~~
24 THAT AFFILIATED SERVICES TO:

25 (1) SUPPORT THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF AFFILIATED
26 SERVICES; AND

27 (2) CONTRIBUTE AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE AMOUNT OF FUNDING
28 PROVIDED FOR THE OPERATION OF AN AFFILIATED SERVICE ~~IN THE COUNTY.~~

29 (D) THE DEPUTY DIRECTOR SHALL ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM.

1 (E) (1) ~~A COUNTY~~ AN AFFILIATED SERVICE MAY SUBMIT AN APPLICATION
2 FOR A PROGRAM GRANT ON THE FORM THAT THE DEPUTY DIRECTOR REQUIRES.

3 (2) AN APPLICATION FOR A PROGRAM GRANT SHALL:

4 ~~(I) IDENTIFY AN AFFILIATED SERVICE OPERATING IN THE~~
5 ~~COUNTY; AND~~

6 ~~(II)~~ INCLUDE A PLAN TO ENSURE THAT THE AFFILIATED
7 SERVICE IS ABLE TO GIFT BOOKS TO ELIGIBLE CHILDREN, INCLUDING CHILDREN IN
8 LOW-INCOME ZIP CODES WITHIN ~~THE COUNTY~~ ITS AREA OF SERVICE.

9 (3) A PROGRAM GRANT SHALL BE DISBURSED TO AN AFFILIATED
10 SERVICE THAT QUALIFIES FOR THE PROGRAM.

11 (F) FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE
12 ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF ~~\$500,000~~ \$250,000 TO THE
13 PROGRAM.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
15 October 1, 2022.
