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Young Readers Programs – Establishment (Young Readers Program Expansion Act)

4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Baltimore City Young Readers Program within the $\mathbf{5}$ Division of Children and Youth of the Governor's Office of Crime Prevention, Youth, 6 and Victim Services to mail free, high-quality books to certain children; establishing 7 the Young Readers Matching Grant Program within the Division to provide 8 matching grants to counties affiliated services to support the establishment and 9 operation of book gifting services; requiring the Deputy Director of the Division to 10 administer the programs; authorizing an affiliated service to apply for a program 11 grant; requiring a program grant to be disbursed to a qualifying affiliated service; 12 and generally relating to Young Readers Programs.
