#### 2 Economic Development – Maryland Makerspace Initiative Program

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Maryland Makerspace Initiative Program in the Maryland Technology Development Corporation; authorizing the Corporation to 4  $\mathbf{5}$ partner with a certain entity to provide technical assistance to certain nonprofit 6 entities and to award certain financial assistance, subject to certain requirements, 7 for the establishment, expansion, and operation of makerspaces in the State; 8 establishing the Maryland Makerspace Initiative Fund as a special, nonlapsing fund; 9 requiring interest earnings of the Fund to be credited to the Fund; providing that 10 certain appropriations and expenditures are subject to audit by the Office of 11 Legislative Audits; and generally relating to the Maryland Makerspace Initiative 12 Program.

3 (1) ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS NOT EXCEEDING \$100,000 IN EACH 4 FISCAL YEAR;

5 (2) REIMBURSEMENT FOR TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE AND MENTORING 6 PROVIDED BY EXISTING MAKERSPACES; AND

7 (3) ANY FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE THAT IS AWARDED TO ELIGIBLE 8 RECIPIENTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 10-4C-04 of this subtitle.

9 (F) FOR EACH OF FISCAL YEARS 2024 THROUGH 2028, THE GOVERNOR 10 SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF AT LEAST 11 \$1,000,000 TO THE FUND.

12 (G) (1) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY OF THE FUND 13 IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE INVESTED.

(a) (2) (i) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, and unless
inconsistent with a federal law, grant agreement, or other federal requirement or with the
terms of a gift or settlement agreement, net interest on all State money allocated by the
State Treasurer under this section to special funds or accounts, and otherwise entitled to
receive interest earnings, as accounted for by the Comptroller, shall accrue to the General
Fund of the State.
