- 4 FOR the purpose of exempting an individual employed by a county or municipality in the 5 State who performs marine contractor services while in the performance of the duties 6 of their employment from paying a fee for the issuance or renewal of a marine 7 contractor license or a test administered by the Marine Contractors Licensing Board; 8 authorizing an individual employed by a county or municipality in the State to 9 perform marine contractor services while in the performance of the duties of their employment without having to obtain a marine contractor license under certain 10 11 circumstances; and generally relating to marine contractor licenses and fees.

- 21 (a) Except as otherwise provided in this title, a person shall be licensed by the 22 Board as a marine contractor or be employed by an individual or entity that is licensed as
- 23 a marine contractor before the person may:
 - (1) Perform marine contractor services in the State; or

ANY OTHER MARINE CONTRACTOR SERVICE THAT 26 THE BOARD DETERMINES WOULD PRESENT A DE MINIMIS RISK TO HUMAN HEALTH 27 OR THE ENVIRONMENT. 28 (II)IF AN INDIVIDUAL IS PERFORMING MARINE CONTRACTOR 29SERVICES FOR THE ROUTINE MAINTENANCE OR REPAIR OF AN EXISTING SHORE EROSION CONTROL STRUCTURE, THE INDIVIDUAL SHALL OBTAIN A LICENSE FROM 30
