- FOR the purpose of authorizing a unit of local government to qualify for a marine contractor 4 5 license; exempting an individual employed by a county or municipality in the State 6 who performs marine contractor services while in the performance of the duties of 7 their employment from paying a fee for the issuance or renewal of a marine 8 contractor license or a test administered by the Marine Contractors Licensing Board; 9 authorizing an individual employed by a county or municipality in the State to 10 perform marine contractor services while in the performance of the duties of their employment without having to obtain a marine contractor license under certain 11 12 circumstances; and generally relating to marine contractor licenses and fees.

- 1 Except as otherwise provided in this title, a person shall be licensed by the 2 Board as a marine contractor or be employed by an individual or entity that is licensed as 3 a marine contractor before the person may: 4 (1) Perform marine contractor services in the State; or 5 **(2)** Solicit to perform marine contractor services in the State. 6 (b) An individual <del>or</del>, an entity, **OR A UNIT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT** may qualify 7 for a license. 8 (c) An individual who is employed by an agency of the federal government or the 9 State may perform marine contractor services while in the performance of the duties of their employment without having to obtain a license from the Board under this title. 10 11 A residential or commercial property owner may perform marine contractor 12 services on the property owner's own property without having to obtain a license from the 13 Board under this title. 14 **(E) (1)** THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS EMPLOYED 15 BY A COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY IN THE STATE. 16 **(2)** AN INDIVIDUAL WHO PERFORMS MARINE CONTRACTOR SERVICES 17 WHILE IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THE DUTIES OF THEIR EMPLOYMENT IS NOT 18 REQUIRED TO PAY A FEE FOR: 19 **(I)** THE ISSUANCE OR RENEWAL OF A LICENSE; OR 20(II)A TEST ADMINISTERED BY THE BOARD. 21**(3)** (I)EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS 22PARAGRAPH, AN INDIVIDUAL MAY PERFORM MARINE CONTRACTOR SERVICES 23 WHILE IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THE DUTIES OF THEIR EMPLOYMENT WITHOUT HAVING TO OBTAIN A LICENSE FROM THE BOARD UNDER THIS TITLE IF THE 2425 INDIVIDUAL IS PERFORMING MARINE CONTRACTOR SERVICES FOR: 26 THE ROUTINE MAINTENANCE OR REPAIR OF A TIDAL 27 IMPOUNDMENT DIKE, AN AGRICULTURAL DRAINAGE DITCH, A HIGHWAY DRAINAGE 28DITCH, A ROADSIDE DRAINAGE DITCH, OR AN OUTLET FOR A ROADSIDE DRAINAGE 29 DITCH; OR 30 2 ANY OTHER MARINE CONTRACTOR SERVICE THAT
- 31 THE BOARD DETERMINES WOULD THAT:

$1\\2$	1. WOULD PRESENT A DE MINIMIS RISK TO HUMAN HEALTH OR THE ENVIRONMENT;
3	2. DO NOT REQUIRE A FEDERAL OR STATE PERMIT; AND
4 5	3. IF THE MARINE CONTRACTOR SERVICES INVOLVE AN EXISTING STRUCTURE, DO NOT INCREASE THE FOOTPRINT OF THE STRUCTURE.
6 7 8 9	(II) IF AN INDIVIDUAL IS PERFORMING MARINE CONTRACTOR SERVICES FOR THE ROUTINE MAINTENANCE OR REPAIR OF AN EXISTING SHORE EROSION CONTROL STRUCTURE, THE INDIVIDUAL SHALL OBTAIN A LICENSE FROM THE BOARD UNDER THIS TITLE.
