- 4 FOR the purpose of extending the termination date for various provisions relating to $\mathbf{5}$ alcoholic beverages manufacturer's licenses and off-site permits, including 6 provisions repealing specified permits and establishing a manufacturer off-site permit and brewery special event permit, altering the fee structure for several 7 8 manufacturer's licenses, authorizing holders of certain manufacturer's licenses to 9 sell and deliver and to directly ship their own alcoholic beverages products to certain individuals under certain circumstances, altering the limitations of the Class 7 10 11 limited beer wholesaler's license, and altering the privileges associated with certain 12licenses; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages, manufacturer's licenses, and 13 off-site permits.
