Requirements - Leases and Health or Safety Emergencies

2	Maryland Economic Development Corporation - Student Housing

4 FOR the purpose of requiring certain residential leases between the Maryland Economic 5 Development Corporation and certain students living in student housing owned by 6 the Corporation to be presented in a certain manner and include a certain notice; 7 requiring the Corporation to give certain notice and abide by certain protocols 8 regarding University System of Maryland students living in student housing owned 9 by the Corporation if the University closes the institution or center the student attends due to a health or safety emergency; and generally relating to the Maryland 10 11 Economic Development Corporation and requirements for student housing.

- 23 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 24That Section(s) 10–131 and 10–132, respectively, of Article – Economic Development of the
- 25 Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 10–133 and 10–134,
- 26 respectively.



SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 Article – Economic Development

- 4 **10–131.**
- 5 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "CORPORATION STUDENT HOUSING PROJECT" MEANS 6 A RESIDENCE HALL, DORMITORY, OR OTHER HOUSING UNITS ESTABLISHED UNDER 7 THIS SUBTITLE.
- 8 (B) A RESIDENTIAL LEASE BETWEEN THE CORPORATION AND A STUDENT 9 LIVING IN A CORPORATION STUDENT HOUSING PROJECT SHALL:
- 10 (1) HAVE AT LEAST ONE CONSPICUOUS REFERENCE TO THE 11 CORPORATION ON THE SIGNATURE PAGE; AND
- 12 (2) MAKE EACH REFERENCE TO THE CORPORATION IN BOLD TYPE 13 AND OTHERWISE EMPHASIZED.
- 14 (C) THE CORPORATION SHALL INCLUDE AN ADDITIONAL NOTICE WITH A CORPORATION STUDENT HOUSING PROJECT RESIDENTIAL LEASE THAT:
- 16 (1) STATES THAT THE CORPORATION IS THE LANDLORD OF THE 17 CORPORATION STUDENT HOUSING PROJECT; AND
- 18 (2) PROVIDES CONTACT INFORMATION FOR THE MANAGEMENT 19 COMPANY OF THE CORPORATION STUDENT HOUSING PROJECT.

- 21 **(A) (1) I**N THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 22 INDICATED.
- 23 (2) "CENTER" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 12–101 OF THE 24 EDUCATION ARTICLE.
- 25 (3) "CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 26 12–101 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE.
- 27 (4) "CORPORATION STUDENT HOUSING PROJECT" HAS THE MEANING 28 STATED IN § 10–131 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

- 1 (5) "HEALTH OR SAFETY EMERGENCY" MEANS AN IMMINENT THREAT
- 2 OR OCCURRENCE OF SEVERE OR WIDESPREAD LOSS OF LIFE, INJURY, OR OTHER
- 3 HEALTH IMPACTS, PROPERTY DAMAGE OR DESTRUCTION, SOCIAL OR ECONOMIC
- 4 DISRUPTION, OR ENVIRONMENTAL DEGRADATION FROM NATURAL,
- 5 TECHNOLOGICAL, OR HUMAN-MADE CAUSES.
- 6 (6) "STUDENT-RESIDENT" MEANS A STUDENT WHO:
- 7 (I) IS ENROLLED AT A CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION OR A
- 8 CENTER; AND
- 9 (II) ENTERS INTO A RESIDENTIAL LEASE WITH THE
- 10 CORPORATION TO LIVE IN A CORPORATION STUDENT HOUSING PROJECT.
- 11 (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO A CORPORATION STUDENT HOUSING
- 12 PROJECT AT A CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION OR A CENTER.
- 13 (C) IF THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM OF MARYLAND CLOSES A CONSTITUENT
- 14 INSTITUTION OR A CENTER DUE TO A HEALTH OR SAFETY EMERGENCY, THE
- 15 CORPORATION SHALL:
- 16 (1) GIVE STUDENT-RESIDENTS THE SAME NOTICE TO VACATE THAT IS
- 17 GIVEN TO A RESIDENT OF STUDENT HOUSING OWNED BY THE CONSTITUENT
- 18 INSTITUTION OR CENTER; AND
- 19 (2) ABIDE BY THE SAME LEASE RELEASE PROTOCOLS THAT ARE IN
- 20 PLACE FOR A RESIDENT OF STUDENT HOUSING OWNED BY THE CONSTITUENT
- 21 INSTITUTION OR CENTER.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to
- 23 apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or
- 24 application to any student-housing contracts entered into by the Maryland Economic
- 25 Development Corporation before the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
- 27 1, 2022.
