- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 (A) THE CENTER SHALL ESTABLISH:

18 (1) A WEBSITE THROUGH WHICH AN INDIVIDUAL MAY ANONYMOUSLY 19 REPORT CLASSROOM DISRUPTIONS AT A PUBLIC SCHOOL; AND

20 (2) AN OFFICE THAT REVIEWS REPORTS RECEIVED UNDER ITEM (1) 21 OF THIS SUBSECTION AND REFERS THE REPORT TO THE APPROPRIATE COUNTY 22 SUPERINTENDENT AND COUNTY BOARD.



1 (B) WITHIN 45 DAYS AFTER RECEIVING A REPORT UNDER SUBSECTION (A) 2 OF THIS SECTION, THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT AND COUNTY BOARD JOINTLY 3 SHALL PROVIDE A RESPONSE TO THE REPORT TO THE OFFICE ESTABLISHED BY THE 4 CENTER UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

5 (C) ON OR BEFORE JUNE 1 EACH YEAR, THE CENTER SHALL MAKE 6 AVAILABLE ON ITS WEBSITE GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE NUMBER AND TYPE 7 OF REPORTS RECEIVED AND RESPONSES PROVIDED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS 8 SECTION.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 10 1, 2022.
