A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **University of Maryland – Employees – Authorization to Fund–Raise**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing an employee of the University of Maryland to solicit gifts
4 or proposals for grants for the benefit of the University of Maryland Medical System
5 Corporation in accordance with certain policies; and generally relating to University
6 of Maryland employees and fund–raising.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 (j) (1) The Board of Directors will coordinate with University fund–raising
22 efforts all Medical System Corporation campaigns and solicitations for private gifts and
23 proposals for private or federal grants.

8 NOTWITHSTANDING §§ 5-505 AND 5-506 OF THE GENERAL PROVISIONS
9 ARTICLE, AN EMPLOYEE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND MAY SOLICIT GIFTS OR
10 PROPOSALS FOR GRANTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND
11 MEDICAL SYSTEM CORPORATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF
12 MARYLAND'S POLICIES REGARDING COORDINATING FUND-RAISING BETWEEN THE
13 UNIVERSITY AND THE MEDICAL SYSTEM CORPORATION.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
15 October 1, 2022.
